Strong condemnation of police violence against LGBTI activists in Istanbul

On the invitation of the Turkish LGBTI activists, an international delegation composed of different politicians from different political families and different NGOs from all over Europe, gathered in Istanbul last weekend.

Yesterday, during the demonstration on the occasion of the ban of the Istanbul Pride, we witnessed violent police actions towards LGBTI activists. Greens/EFA MEP Terry Reintke, member of the LGBTI Intergroup of the European Parliament was as well arrested by the police and then released. 29 activists in total had been detained and all of them have been released later in the night.

We firmly condemn what happened last weekend and we need to highlight the difficult situation facing LGBTI people everyday in Turkey.
